Departure from USA to Athens, Greece.

### DAY 3 – ATHENS

After breakfast, your day will begin in this ancient city as the knowledge and guidance of a licensed guide will assist you with a sightseeing tour of Athens.

You will be visiting the Acropolis, its museum as well as the Temple of Zeus, the Parliament and the Panathinaiko Stadio. Your afternoon is at leisure so don't hesitate to visit the Athenian coast before having dinner at a beautiful little marina by the port of Piraeus.

### DAY 4 – ATHENS

Your entire day is at leisure. Spend some time at Constitution Square viewing the changing of the guards at the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier.

### DAY 5 – ATHENS / PIRAEUS.....CRUISE

Your morning is at your leisure. In the late afternoon, transfer to Piraeus to board the ship for your 7-day cruise to the Greek Islands and Turkey.

### DAY 6 – ISTANBUL

After breakfast, take an optional excursion to the City of Istanbul where you will visit Aghia Sophia, the Topkapi Palace, the Blue Mosque, Grand Bazaar and much more.

### DAY 7 – MYKONOS

### DAY 8 – MYKONOS

### DAY 11 – HERAKLION / SANTORINI

Arrive in Heraklion, the capital of Crete. Take an optional excursion to the palace of King Minos at Knossos and the museum. Sail on to the beautiful island of Santorini where some recent excavations conclude that this island might be the fabled continent of Atlantis.

### DAY 12 – PIRAEUS / ATHENS / USA

Return to Piraeus. Disembark after breakfast and transfer to the airport for your return flight home.



## TERMS & CONDITIONS

**RESERVATIONS:** Please forward your written acceptance of our proposal by letter or e-mail along with the required deposit and Hellenic Holidays will immediately book all arrangements. Upon confirmation, Hellenic Holidays will issue a final itinerary for services rendered. The balance of payment will be due 60 days prior to departure. If travel dates are within 60 days of this reservation request, the deposit amount is non-refundable and full payment is due with your request for services.

**DEPOSIT AND PAYMENT:** A \$500.00 per person deposit (excluding all airfare) is required with your acceptance letter. All Final payments are due 60 days prior to departure. Reservations are subject to a \$50 per person late fee if final payment is not received by the due date. Payments must be made in U.S. funds by personal or company check, bank check, cash, or credit card (American Express, VISA and Mastercard). Please make checks payable to Hellenic Holidays, Inc. Late reservations (those received less than 30 days prior to departure) will be charged a late booking fee of \$ 50 per person in the final itinerary to cover addition costs. Applicants residing outside the United States will not be accepted. Wedding requests must be made a minimum of three months prior to departure.

**AIR TRANSPORTATION:** Non Stop Round trip economy air from New York on IATA carriers is included, except as noted in each inclusive tour. Air add-ons from other U.S. cities are available on request. Any changes made by the passenger that may result in higher airfares will be the responsibility of the passenger. Certain restrictions apply. Air taxes, security taxes and fuel surcharges are additional.

**RATES:** Inclusive tour rates in this brochure quoted in U.S. Dollars are based on tariffs in effect at time of printing and are subject to change in the event of currency fluctuations or increase in costs. All services are based on availability at the time of booking, thus prices may need to be adjusted as travel dates are determined and services are confirmed. Lodging in our recommended packages has been chosen for charm, service and location and have been inspected for such. Services such as lodging and car rental may be upgraded or downgraded to meet your individual desires. We would be happy to discuss these options.

**HOTELS:** Rates are based on standard rooms in all hotels specified, or similar, with private facilities including service and taxes, continental or American breakfasts and any other meals specified in itineraries. Hellenic Holidays reserves the right to substitute hotels and cruise ships should the hotels and or cruise ships showcased are not available and to alter itineraries.

**CRUISES:** All cruise cabins have private facilities. All tours are based on minimum inside cabins with two lower beds. Supplements for higher category cabins than provided are available. Port charges, shore excursions and fuel surcharges are additional. Shore excursions may be purchased at time of reservation.

**TRANSFERS:** Transfers are included as specified in Tour Includes for each tour package.

**EXCURSIONS AND SIGHTSEEING:** All excursions are specified in respective tour packages and will be provided with deluxe motor coaches and locally escorted by English speaking guides. Most entrance fees to places visited are included.
